## **SPECIFICATIONS**

**Digital Images Only** should be JPEG files submitted on a CD which can be read by a PC *AND* a MAC. JPEG images should not exceed 1600 pixels in any dimension and should have a maximum file size of 1 MB. Title of work, medium, dimensions and title number that corresponds with that image on the Entry Form as follows:

All 2D work must be completely prepared for hanging. Size limitations: 2D: maximum 6 feet in any direction. Floor installation: 48x48 inches. 3D: 4 feet in any direction. NO ceiling hung work. Electronic and digital works must be ready to show - artists must provide all components. Monitors only - no projections.

# Alexandra Schwartz

Ms. Schwartz is the Curator of Contemporary Art at the Montclair Art Museum where she is currently organizing a series of solo exhibitions of contemporary artists, beginning with "Marina Zurkow: Friends, Enemies and Others" and a major traveling exhibition, New Order: Art and Politics in the 1990s (Fall 2013). She was previously the coordinator of The Museum of Modern Art's Modern Women's Project and curator of Mind and Matter: Alternative Abstractions, 1940 to Now at MoMA PS1. Ms. Schwartz is the author of Ed Ruscha's Los Angeles (MIT Press, 2010) and has contributed to various journals, anthologies and exhibition catalogues. She has taught at Columbia University and in the Education Departments at MoMA and the Whitney Museum of American Art. She received a Ph.D. from the University of Michigan and a B.A. from Harvard University.

# **ENTRY FEE**

A non-refundable fee of \$40 for three images (jpgs) on one CD or three videos on one DVD. SMI members pay \$30. Two views of 3D work will be accepted.

# **ELIGIBILITY**

Open to all fine artists. All media accepted including videos and installations. Work not conforming to the submission will be rejected. Work must have been completed within the past 2 years.

### LIABILITY

Artists must provide own insurance. Studio Montclair and the Ben Shahn Galleries reserve the right to photograph and use accepted work for documentation, website, publicity or catalogue purposes...

### ENTRY PROCEDURE

- I. JPG's must be labeled as above. CHECK your CD before sending.
- 2 Artists must provide a SASE for return of CD. If CD is not to be returned, artists must provide #10 SASE for return of notification.
