Montclair, NJ (April, 2017) – Studio Montclair presents its 20th Annual Open Juried Exhibition, "ViewPoints 2017," to run from June 1 through June 30, 2017 at *aljira, a Center for Contemporary Art*, 591 Broad Street, Newark, NJ. An opening reception and announcement of cash awards will take place on Saturday, June 3 from 6 to 9pm.

This year's show features 87 works selected from more than 1,000 that were submitted by artists from every region of the US, as well as Canada, Europe, and Asia. States curator Karen Wilkin, "The submissions to ViewPoints 2017 reflected today's multivalence of conception, approach, and medium, so the selection of work to be exhibited had to honor widely differing possibilities without compromising aesthetic values." The result is an exhibition of work that cuts across a broad range of media and techniques, including oil painting, various forms of photography, clay, fabric, metal, wood, and mixed media.

About the Juror

Karen Wilkin is a curator and critic specializing in 20th century modernism. Educated at Barnard College and Columbia University, she was awarded a Woodrow Wilson Fellowship and a Fulbright Scholarship to Rome. From 1971 through 1978, she was Chief Curator of the Art Gallery of Alberta, Canada. She is the author of monographs on Stuart Davis, David Smith, Kenneth Noland, Helen Frankenthaler, and George Braque. Ms. Wilkin teaches in the MFA program of the New York Studio School and is Contributing Editor for the *Hudson Review*. She also contributes regularly to *The New Criterion* and the *Wall Street Journal*.
