MONTCLAIR, NJ (September, 2016) – Studio Montclair presents the exhibit "Without Borders," to run from October 21 through December 16, 2016 at Academy Square Galleries, 33 Plymouth Street, Montclair, NJ. An opening reception will be held on October 21, 2016, from 6 to 9pm, the same night as Montclair's ArtWalk.

The show features two- and three-dimensional works that break with conventional boundaries of the traditional square or rectangular format. The selection includes fiber and paper installations, wall relief sculpture, freestanding sculpture, photography, video, stitched compositions, and paintings.

Explains co-curator Virginia Block, "We were looking for work that not only stretched the limitations of the traditional boundaries that artists work within, but also the manner in which the artists used their materials and mediums."

Among the show's unconventional materials are melted Tyvek as a choice for support, stained and shaped canvas presented with traditional stretcher bars, and felt. "Without Borders" is also the first group exhibit at Studio Montclair's Academy Square Galleries to include two site-specific installations: one featuring the work of Kansas City textile artist Laura Sobchak and the other featuring the work of South Orange collagist Florence Weisz.

While the majority of the 26 featured artists are from New Jersey, several are from out-of-state including from New York, Pennsylvania, New Hampshire, and Missouri.
